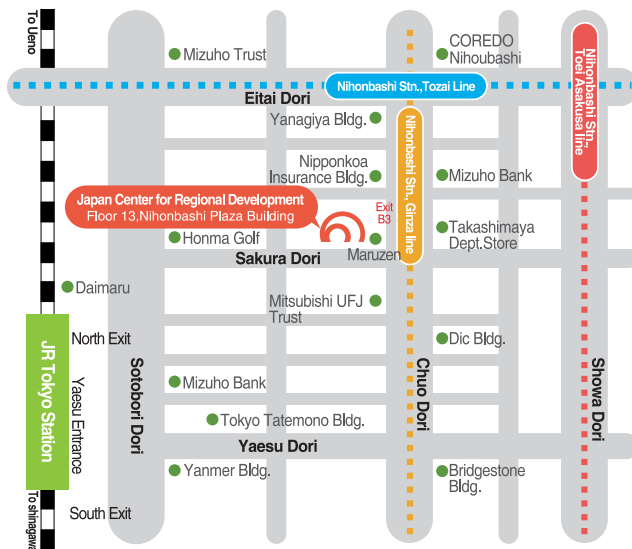


About JCRD
